



Schedule and Locations

SHARE! Advanced Peer Specialist Training consists of three consecutive courses, which prepare people to serve as peers with lived experience, working in the public mental health system:

- a. Peer Services 101
- b. SHARE! Peer Toolkit
- c. Peer Bridging

The courses will be offered one after another. Participants will earn a certificate for each course they successfully complete. To earn certificate, students must attend each class, complete homework assignments, conduct field investigations, attend self-help support groups and pass a final examination.

If you are working as a peer or parent partner in the public mental health system, such as at a client-run center, wellness center, homeless outreach, or other mental health setting, you are eligible for SHARE!'s free training for Peer Specialists. The next class will be:

Saturday, June 3, 2017 at SHARE! Downtown at 425 S. Broadway, Los Angeles CA 90013. Downtown has great access by bus and metro. Please note that the parking downtown costs \$7 to \$10. Alternatively, if you interested in working with young people or transition-age youth in the public mental health system, you may earn a certification in Peer Specialist for Youth. In collaboration with Loyola Marymount University, SHARE! is teaching this class geared for people interested in supporting young people and transition-age youth. Mental health consumers 18 and over, as well as parents and caregivers of mental health consumers, are encouraged to apply.
