FOLLOW UP S.Y.S.T.E.M.

(<u>s</u>aves <u>y</u>ou <u>s</u>tress, <u>t</u>ime, <u>e</u>nergy & <u>m</u>oney)

Have a plan

- 1. Send an email to the person(s) you spoke to within 36 hours.
- 2. Keep it short, sweet and focused on them
- 3. Connect on social media, give value
- 4. Invite them to an event or schedule a one-on-one





BE ORGANIZED

- 1. Use phone/calendar reminders to follow up.
- 2. Input their information in your contacts, noting when and how you met them.
- 3. Choose a future date to reach out again.
- 4. Ask if they would like to receive email newsletters or project updates. (Don't assume)
